

Swimming pool rules

The pool attendant(s) are responsible for safety at the pool and for compliance with these pool rules. They act on behalf of the Management Board. Their instructions must be followed at all times.

The Club accepts no liability for accidents, injuries or losses that occur while using Club facilities, in particular the pool.

Parents and/or adults accompanying children are responsible for their behaviour and may be liable. They must fulfil their duty of supervision at all times, including at the children's pool.

Out of consideration for other bathers and neighbours, boisterous behaviour and loud noise should be avoided.

Before using the pool, you must shower at poolside or in the changing rooms.

The showers and changing rooms must be left in a clean condition.

It goes without saying that appropriate swimwear must be worn.

Jumping into the pool from the edge is prohibited, as is pushing people into the pool or running along the edge of the pool.

Only swimmers are permitted to use the pool. Children who do not have the German "Seepferdchen" swimming proficiency badge may only swim in the shallow area of the pool under the permanent supervision and responsibility of their parents. Parents have an increased duty to be present and supervise their children at all times.

The consumption of brought-in food and drinks is not permitted anywhere on the club premises. The pool bar and restaurants offer a wide selection of food and drinks.

Mobile phones and other electronic devices may only be used in

other members or guests. Special consideration is requested when using mobile phones.

Smokers are asked to show special consideration for other members and guests throughout the club grounds and to refrain from smoking in the immediate pool area. At weekends and on public holidays, smoking is only permitted in the outside restaurant areas and on the sunbathing lawn.

For reasons of hygiene, the sunbed cushions must always be completely covered with towels.

The reservation of sunbeds is not permitted.

The use of crockery or other items made of glass or other breakable materials is prohibited in the entire pool area.

Diving masks, snorkels and fins as well as buoyancy aids (balls, air mattresses, etc.) are not permitted in the pool.

The life guard attendant may restrict or prohibit the use of the pool in whole or in part at any time.

In the event of a thunderstorm or gale, the pool must be vacated immediately.

Express reference is made to the ICB club rules, insofar as they go beyond these swimming pool rules.
